

## Standing Orders - Fylde weekend Dates - 20<sup>th</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup> August

**Parking and Camping:** Plastic camp within the Triangle area - located at the junction of Fairlawn Road and West Beach/A584 (see attached map) on the sea side. Must display in windscreen the attached vehicle pass with their name and mobile number written on the pass. There are to be **no fires** in this area.

**NOTE:** a few issues re camping on top of the "no fires"

- The group must keep their campsite noise to a minimum. The Triangle is set next to a set of residents who are prone to complaining to the council. They did not want camping in this area. We need to be on best behaviour
- There will be toilets in this area but we do not have access to running water. Nor are there any lights other than street lights. The closest water may be at the Lowther Pavilion.
- There will be security on duty from Friday morning until Sunday night. They will patrol the whole of the area and some of them may be camping in the Triangle as well.
- Campers must take all litter home with them. Please ask them to bring a large black bag with them
- Once the Triangle has filled up with maximum campers we **can not** have plastic camp spilling outside of the Triangle. Late arrivals or campers with no room will have to go to a public campsite (with careful parking we should be able to accommodate)

**Historic Vehicles** - could the historic vehicles that will be on display and in the procession print out one of the attached "Historic vehicle pass". I appreciate that the vehicle may not want to display this directly as it may detract from the authentic look but the owner must have the pass with the vehicle somewhere as they may be challenged by Security to verify their legitimacy as part of the show. We will not allow vehicles that do not have this pass.

**Departure** - You will need to depart Sunday evening from the site so all take down and removal will need to be done after show close at 17.00

Any extra help with props for the battle field would really be appreciated!!

**Wood** – be a good idea to bring a supply of wood if possible, although some is available.
